Beginners Getting to grips with a DSLR camera and tripod - 1 hour 30 minute session

For those who wish to get to grips with handling a camera and using a tripod includes an introduction to photography basics with tea and coffee upon arrival. This is not a practical landscape session, this session is more theory based for those of you are unsure of your camera and need help with photography basics. We will also spend some time during this session getting used to the camera & tripod. This is a good individual session but I am also happy to run this session during the same day prior to one of the practical landscape workshops so you can then utilize and build upon what you have learnt during this session out in the field.

Creative seascape photographic workshop - 2 hour session
